Attendance Policy

At least one week prior to an absence parents are to email the DRE [sorrows.faith.formation@gmail.com]. In the case of illness or family emergency parents will have two days after the absence to email. Make-up "assignments" will consist of students attending a Parish event of their choice and completing a form about that event. After 4 absences a meeting will be scheduled between the DRE and parents to decide on a course of action moving forward.

Faith Formation Mass

Faith Formation Mass will be held once a month at the 11:00 A.M. mass. Students will arrive by 10:45 A.M. and sit with their class for mass. These are required as mass is an essential part of our Catholic faith. Missing one of these masses will be treated the same way as missing class [see attendance policy above].

Family Day

There will be 3 family days this school year. They will take place after the Faith Formation mass in the hall. This will be an opportunity for family Faith building, and ideas on how to bring Faith formation into everyday life. Missing one of these Family Days will be treated the same way as missing class [see attendance policy above].

Christmas Program

HOORAY! We are bringing back the Christmas program this year! [Date TBD] This will be an opportunity for families to celebrate the seasons. There will be Christmas goodies to snack on, a musical performance by the students and a "Keep Christ in Christmas" poster contest hosted by the Knights of Columbus with prizes!
